
Subject: Critical imports of both Chemicals & Petrochemicals and logistics – regarding.
Sir,

I am directed to convey that a meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (Shipping), Ministry of Shipping regarding review of critical imports and logistic thereof.

2. In this context, it is requested to furnish the information on the following to this Department **at the earliest:**

- (i) Number of critical Chemicals & Petrochemicals to be imported during any exigency at least for 45 days period.
- (ii) To provide the list of critical Chemicals and Petrochemicals which are required for 45 days in case of any exigency and also the source of import and destinations.
- (iii) In case of the west-cost is prohibited for import of these chemicals during any exigency, what are the alternative ports available on the east-cost for handling these chemicals and petrochemicals?
- (iv) Alternative source of procurement and alternative destinations to store these critical chemicals.
